SPRAZOL

A highly concentrated, all purpose cleaner that can be used for multitude of applications. Use at lower dilutions for routine cleaning and at higher dilutions for heavy duty cleaning and degreasing. Will not leave streaks on hard surfaces. Removes grease, dirt, black-heel and scuff marks, crayon, pencil, mold, and soot. Sprazol contains corrosion inhibitors for use on metals, such as engines and other machinery.

Safe for most surfaces, however, do not use for routine cleaning on floors with an acrylic or acrylic/urethane finish at over 1 oz./ gallon dilution. Floors coated with an oil-modified urethane will not be harmed. Do not use strong dilutions on polished aluminum, magnesium, painted and varnished surfaces. Biodegradeable, low-sudsing and pleasantly scented.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Dilute with cold water

- For all purpose spray and wipe cleaning, use 2 ounces per gallon. Spray on surface, let dwell and wipe clean with a cloth or paper towel. No rinse necessary.
- For heavy duty spray and wipe cleaning and degreasing, use 3 8 ounces per gallon. Spray on surface, let dwell and wipe clean with a cloth or paper towel. No rinse necessary.
- For use with a pressure washer, use 3 8 ounces per gallon. Apply with low pressure onto surface, let dwell, and rinse with high pressure mode.
- For damp mopping light soil or in automatic scrubbing machines, use ½-1 ounces per gallon. No rinse required. Not recommended for daily cleaning of floors finished with floor finish.
- For damp mopping heavy soil, or in automatic scrubbers, use 2 ounces per gallon. No rinse required
- For routine mopping of kitchen floors, use 2 ounces per gallon. Change mop water frequently as it becomes soiled.
- For deep restorative cleaning and degreasing of grouted floors including kitchens and restrooms, use 4-8 ounces per gallon. Apply solution with an autoscrubber, mop or applicator, double scrub the area with the autoscrubber or floor machine and then pick up the used solution from surface with an autoscrubber, clean mop or wet-vacuum pick-up.

- For deep scrubbing floors finished with floor finishes with an autoscrubber, use 2 ounces per gallon. Apply the solution without the vacuum and the squeegee in the up position. Double scrub the area and then vacuum up the solution. Final rinse with Winterclean 365 before applying floor finish.
- For deep scrubbing floors finished with floor finishes with manual equipment, use 2 ounces per gallon. Apply the solution with a mop or applicator. Double scrub the area with a floor machine then pick up the used solution with a clean mop or wet-vacuum. Final rinse with Winterclean 365 before applying floor finish.

NOTE: This product will remove floor finish. Do not use full strength. If spilled, wipe up immediately
