## TONE UP GEL RESTORER

A unique gel restorer that is used by dispensing a small strip of product under a floor machine pad and buffing. Each 3-5 inch strip of Tone Up will give a sensational “wet look” shine to approximately 300-500 square feet of floor area during high speed buffing. Tone Up can be used with any floor machine, however machines over 1200 RPM give the best results. Tone Up cleans and restores the “wet look” shine on any floor coated with an acrylic or an acrylic/urethane finish. It gives extra protection to the floor resulting in a longer life for the finish. Floors take on an incredibly deep gloss while slip resistance is also increased. Tone Up can also be used on uncoated marble, polished granite, ceramic and terrazzo.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**NOTE:** Only use on floors coated with an acrylic or acrylic/urethane finish or uncoated polished stone.

1. Sweep and dust mop floor prior to use. For best results damp mop or or autoscrub floor with Blue-J Formula neutral cleaner or Maintainer and let dry.
2. Dispense a 3-5 inch strip of TONE UP on floor surface. Place buffing pad on strip with motor off. (A white polishing pad will give the highest gloss).
3. Start buffing machine and spread TONE UP over an area of about 300-500 square feet.
4. A deeper gloss can be achieved by buffing the area a second time.
